

The <u>Welch Responsive Temperament Assessment</u>, or WRTA, is a scientifically researched psychological assessment measuring a person's temperament within a range of four (4), and their level of *responsiveness* (voluntary, deliberate, relationship-enhancing behaviors originating from the brain's cerebral cortex) vs *reactivity* (involuntary, unplanned, relationship-impeding behaviors originating from the brain's limbic system) within nine (9) trait-pairs called *Dimensions of Expression*. This powerful diagnostic tool gives the counselor/practitioner valuable insight into an individual and couple's patterns of behavior that may be hindering their ability to develop and sustain healthy and thriving relationships. When combined with the <u>Responsive Relationship Handbook</u>, the WRTA practitioner is empowered to guide their clients towards reducing *reactivity* and increasing *responsiveness*, thereby improving their relationships.


The WRTA Level 1 Certification Training provides participants with foundational concepts needed to use the WRTA with those they counsel. The training consists of the following elements:

- 3-minute introductory video
- 40-minute training video
- Time for the participant to take the Welch Responsive Temperament Assessment as an Individual or as a Couple
- 30 question, multiple choice exam to test the participant's acquired knowledge of the concepts covered in the training video with a minimum score of 70% (21 questions correct) required to become CERTIFIED
- Ability to re-watch the training video and retake the exam as many times as necessary to pass
- Certificate of Completion and Certificate for one (1) continuing education unit/hour (CEU) credit
  accepted by the California Association of Marriage and Family Therapists (CAMFT) emailed to
  participant upon successful passage of the Certification Exam
- Option to register to be on the <u>WRTA Proficient Practitioners List</u> published on the Welch Family
  Therapy Institute's website for potential clients to find practitioners who use the WRTA and Responsive
  Relationship tools in their practice
- 3-minute tutorial video providing instructions on accessing the WRTA Facilitator Portal and setting up the participant's unique facilitator code to be used by their clients when they take the WRTA
- Continuing access to WRTA Facilitator Portal to view and analyze WRTA results for clients




Terms of Service




After finishing the training video, click STEP 4: Take the 30 Question Proficiency Exam.

Answer each question by clicking A, B, C, or D; then click **Next.** 



- 7. Once you pass the exam, you will be granted access to the WRTA Facilitator Portal Access product. Do the following:













